Department News





- The Winter Session of Active Adult (55+) Classes began with a total of 154 participants and Adult Fitness Classes began with a total of 120 participants
- A total of 1,425 senior meals were delivered in January- a 24% increase from January 2017
- Indoor Walk and Fit (a free program designed to give seniors a warm, dry space to walk during the winter months) began with 24 individuals registered
- The department submitted park metrics data to the National Parks and Recreation Association (NRPA) for the annual Angency Performance Review. An official report comparing our department data to the national average, as well as similar cities, will be available in the Spring.
