

VICINITY MAP: FROG POND WEST NEIGHBORHOOD










FROG POND WEST STREET DEMONSTRATION PLAN


Master Plan Street Demonstration Plan with Tree Overlay

NATURAL RESOURCE ENHANCEMENT

Degraded existing condition

- » Invasive Himalayan blackberry
- » Non-native grasses and weeds
- » Generally lacking tree canopy and woody understory vegetation
- » Tree stumps site historically logged

Habitat Enhancement Plan

- » 12,658 sq. ft. of enhancement area within SROZ buffer
- » Removal of invasive species
- » 127 native trees
 - » 30 Bigleaf Maples
 - » 30 Oregon White Oaks
 - » 30 Douglas Firs
 - » 20 Cascaras
 - » 17 Pacific Dogwoods
- » 633 native shrubs
 - » Snowberry, Oregon Grape, Beaked Hazelnut, Pineland Sword Fern, Baldhip Rose, Red Flowering Currant
- » Native groundcover





PROJECT BENEFITS



Provides needed housing

» **38 lots** for future single-family homes



Visual and physical access to nature

- » Constructs Boeckman Trail and dedicates land to the public
- » Habitat enhancement within Natural Resource Area
- » Retains mature Oregon White Oaks



Transportation system improvements

- » Right-of-way dedication for widening of Frog Pond Lane
- » New 52-foot-wide Local and 64-foot-wide Collector **public streets**
