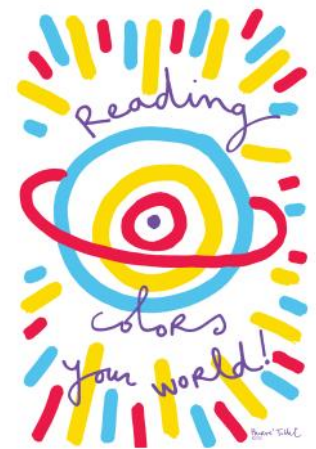
Programs for all ages will be online. Toddler/Baby Time and Stories & Science (our summer Storytime) will be live and interactive through Zoom.

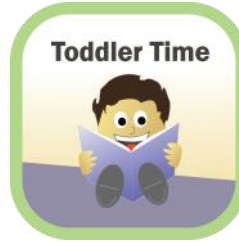

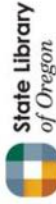
