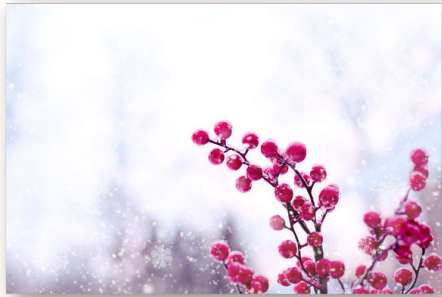


# Library Services Manager retires

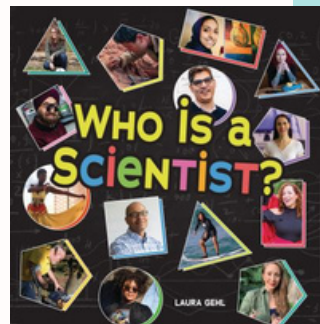

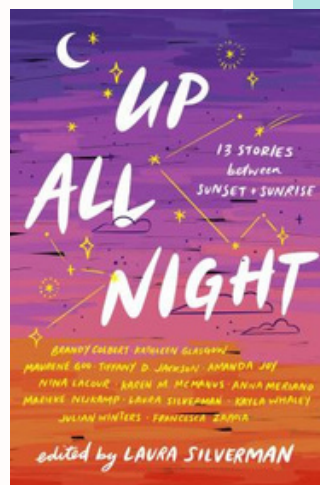
**Stacey's Extraordinary Words** by Stacey Abrams

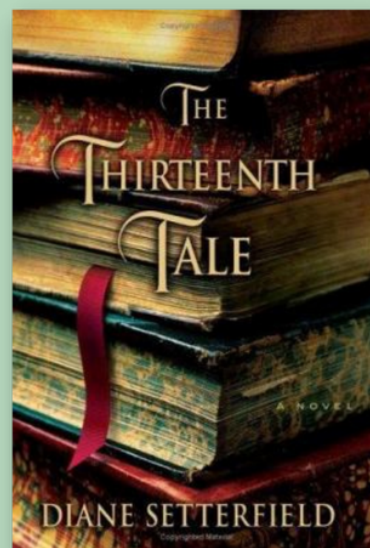
