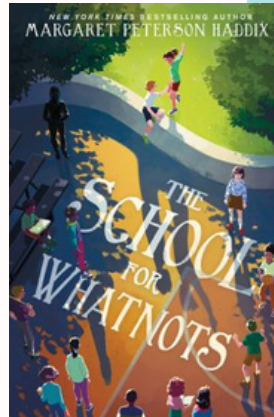

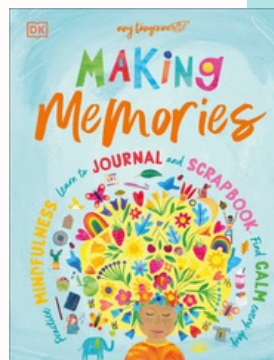

by Margaret Peterson Haddix

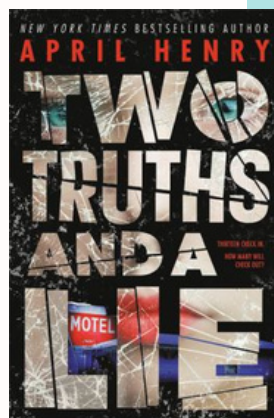
Max searches for his best friend who disappeared, leaving behind a strange note.
