StoryWalk in Villebois

The Library has teamed up with Wilsonville Parks & Recreation to combine two of our favorite things: story sharing and outdoor exploring!

A StoryWalk is a fun way to enjoy reading and the outdoors at the same time. Laminated pages from an illustrated book are attached to signs, which are installed along a paved, outdoor path. As you make your way down the trail, you are directed to the next page in the story. Stories are changed out on a regular basis.

StoryWalk is now a permanent feature at Tivoli Park, along a paved trail that is accessible to all, and begins at the intersection of SW Denmark Street and SW Coffee Lake Drive in Villebois.

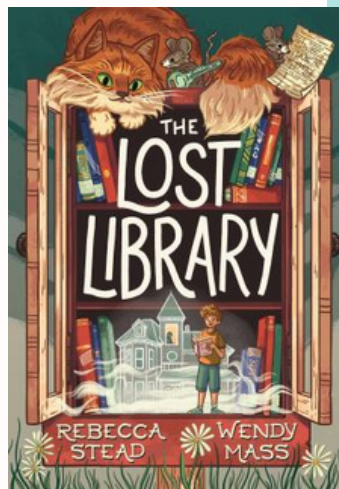

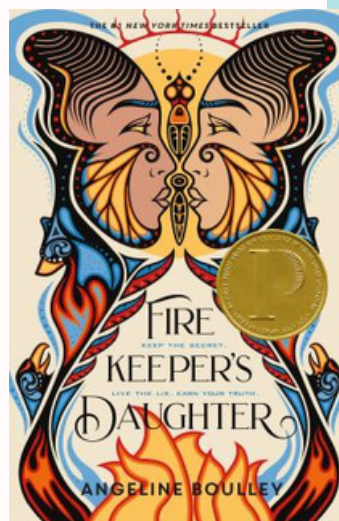
***Big* by Vashti Harrison**

Why is NASA interested in Psyche, the largest metal asteroid discovered so far? What is it going to take to get to it? What discoveries do we hope to make?

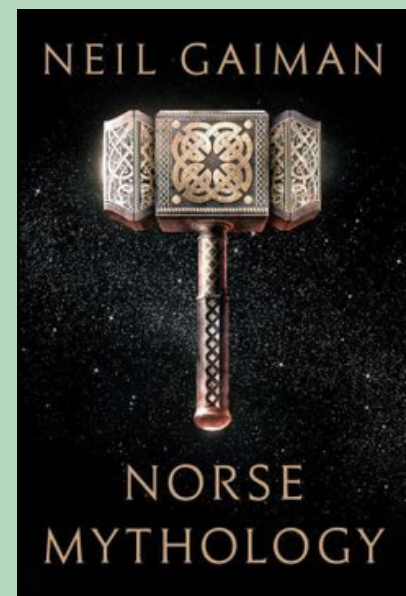
