ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE EXTENSION OF CITY UTILITIES BEYOND THE CITY LIMITS WITH EXCEPTIONS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 33; AND DECLARING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: After the effective date of this Ordinance, water, sewer, gas, electric and other utilities furnished by the City of Wilsonville to or for its inhabitants shall not be extended beyond the corporate limits of the City to serve any person, firm or corporation except:

- a. For service to an agency or department of Federal, State or County government.
- b. For water service for domestic purposes only to the dwelling house now owned by Pauline B. Laird in Tax Lot 600, Section 1, T. 3 S., R. 1 W. of the W.M., Washington County, Oregon, the address of which is: 7845 S.W. Elligsen Road, Tualatin, Oregon.
- c. In any other case which the City Council by Resolution determines the need for the extension of any utility service beyond the corporate limits of the City and authorizes the extension by such Resolution.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 33 enacted by the City Council on February 26, 1973, is hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the Wilsonville City Council.

Passed by the Wilsonville City Council on first reading this 9th day of September, 1974; ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Wilsonville for a period five (5) consecutive days as required by the Wilsonville City Charter; and to come up for final reading and action of the Council at a meeting thereof to be held on the 23 day of September, 1974, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. at the Wilsonville City Hall.
