## ORDINANCE NO. 47 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 17 RELATING TO FEES OF ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 23; PROVIDING FOR BASE FEES AND SUPPLEMENTARY DEPOSITS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1: AMENDMENTS TO ZONING ORDINANCE FEE SCHEDULE. Article 17 relating to fees of Zoning Ordinance No. 23 enacted June 1, 1971, and amended by Ordinance No. 32 enacted September 11, 1972, is hereby amended and changed to provide as follows: ARTICLE 17. **FEES** "SECTION 17.01 FEES: Fees are for the purpose of defraying administrative costs and base fees are not refundable. 2. Fees payable at the time of application shall be: Type of Proceeding Base Fee \$200.00 A. . . Zone Change B. . . Conditional Use 100.00 C. . . Expansion of Non-Conforming Use 50.00 D. . . Variance 50.00 E. . Temporary Use 50.00 F. . . Appeals 20.00 SECTION 17.02 ADDITIONS TO BASE FEE: In addition to the base fee, each application under the above proceedings shall be accompanied by a \$200.00 technical services deposit. When special engineering, planning or legal services are required to investigate and check the application for compliance with applicable laws and regulations and to process the matter before the Planning Commission or City Council, the deposit will be utilized by the City to pay for resulting actual costs. If the deposit is reduced to \$25.00 or less by cost payments, a supplementary deposit of \$200.00 shall be made by the applicant. Proceedings upon the application Page 1. ORDINANCE NO. 47

will be suspended until the supplementary deposit has been made. If actual expenses incurred are less than amounts deposited, the balance will be returned to the applicant within 60 days from the termination of proceedings."

Section 2: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: EMERGENCY DECLARATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

Inasmuch as the City's administrative costs now exceed the fees charged for the above proceedings, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the Council.

Passed by the Wilsonville City Council on first reading this 28th day of April, 1975; ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Wilsonville for a period of five (5) consecutive days as required by the Wilsonville City Charter; and to come up for final reading and action of the Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 19th day of May, 1975, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. at the Wilsonville City Hall.
