AFFIDAVIT OF POSTING ORDINANCE #57

ORDINANCE NO. 57 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BULK WATER RATES; PRESCRIBING FEES FOR USE OF HYDRANTS; REQUIRING APPLICATIONS FOR BULK WATER PURCHASES; AUTHORIZING CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SUPERVISE BULK WATER SALES AND USE OF HYDRANTS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1: AUTHORIZING BULK SALES OF WATER. The City of Wilsonville will sell bulk water from the City's municipal water supply providing: The City Administrator determines that there is sufficient City water for any requested bulk water sale. A written application for each purchase is first filed with the City Administrator on such forms as he may prescribe. The application is first approved by the City Administrator. d. The applicant pays in advance the purchase price of the estimated water requirement at the bulk water rate as specified in the following Section 2 and the fee for use of a hydrant as specified in the following Section 3. The applicant agrees in his application to comply with the terms thereof and the provisions of this Ordinance, and pay in full the total purchase price for the water purchased and within the time limited therefor. Section 2: BULK WATER RATE. All bulk water sold after the effective date of this Ordinance shall be at the rate of 50¢ per 100 cubic feet, and full payment for all water purchased shall be made to the City Administrator within 72 hours. Section 3: HYDRANT CONNECTION FEE. All applicants for purchase of bulk water shall pay a \$5.00 connection fee for each use of a City water hydrant. Section 4: REQUIREMENTS FOR CONNECTIONS TO HYDRANTS. connections to City water hydrants for purchase of bulk water shall be made at such times and places as directed by the City Administrator and under his supervision. Connection shall be made with an appropriate hydrant valve and hydrant wrench which shall either be furnished by the City Administrator or first approved by him. Any Page 1. ORDINANCE NO. 57

loaned use of a City valve or wrench is subject to a return deposit of \$10.00 for a wrench and \$200.00 for a hydrant valve.

Section 5: DAMAGE TO CITY PROPERTY AND UNAUTHORIZED USE

OF CITY WATER. Anyone causing damage to City water hydrants or
other City property as the result of connections or attempted
connections to water hydrants or other City water sources and
anyone using or taking or attempting to use or take City water
from a City water hydrant or other source of City water supply
without an approved permit shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor
and punished upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$500.00
or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than six months,
or by both such fine and imprisonment. Also, the City Administrator
may institute and prosecute a civil action in the name of the City
for the recovery of damages to City property and/or the taking of
City water without payment and for the City's reasonable attorney's
fees as may be allowed by the Court having jurisdiction of such
matter.

Section 6: EMERGENCY DECLARED AND EFFECTIVE DATE. Inasmuch as there is unauthorized use of City water hydrants and taking of City water without permission and a resulting loss of City revenue, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and enactment by the Wilsonville City Council.

Passed on first reading of the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof on the 3rd day of November, 1975; ordered posted as provided by the Wilsonville City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on Monday, the 17th day of November, 1975, at the hour of 8:00 p.m. at the Wilsonville Grade

School.
