BE IT RESOLVED that the Wilsonville City Council hereby adopts the Budget approved by the Budget Committee of the City of Wilsonville on June 26, 1972, now on file with the office of the City Recorder.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the Budget in the aggregate amount of \$38,300.000, and those taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property with the City of Wilsonville, as of 1:00 am January 1, 1972; and
