

RESOLUTION NO. LXXIII (73)

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CLACKAMAS COUNTY ELECTION DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT 1976 REGULAR CITY PRIMARY ELECTION.

It is hereby RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that the Clackamas County Election Department be requested to conduct the City's Primary Election between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, May 25, 1976, in conjunction with the Statewide Primary Election which will be held at the same time, on the same date and in each of the regular polling places in the City of Wilsonville; and to certify the results of said City Election to the Wilsonville City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder prepare and furnish to the said County Election Department a form of the City's Ballot for preparation of the official punchcard ballot to be furnished to the voters and used in said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Wilsonville pay the County Election Department the City's proportionate share of the election costs for conducting the City election and upon receipt of proper billing from the County.
