## RESOLUTION NO. 92

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING ELEGIBILITY FOR THE RECEIPT OF STATE-SHARED REVENUES BY THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for the disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785, to 366.820 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more the following services:

- (1) Police Protection
- (2) Fire Protection
- (3) Street Construction, Maintenance and Lighting
- (4) Sanitary Sewers
- (5) Storm Sewers
- (6) Planning, Zoning and Subdivision Control
- (7) One or More Utility Services

and

WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the elegibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Wilsonville, Oregon hereby certifies that it provides for or contracts for the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

Planning, Zoning & Sub

Fire Protection

Police Protection
