RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that the agreement by and between the State of Oregon by and through its Department of Transportation, Highway Division, and the City of Wilsonville, a copy of which is attached hereto entitled "AGREEMENT" and marked FXHIBIT "A" for further identification purposes, is approved; and the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver said agreement and all required to expand in the name of and on behalf of the City c

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the letter commitment dated April 18, 1979 by District Engineer William W. Geibel to the Cluy Administrator, Ed Bavis, for road maintenance "in the next five years" is a part of the consideration which induced the Council's approval of the Exhibit "A" agreement; and a copy of said letter is
