RESOLUTION NO. 128 SHARING MONEY AND APPOINTING AN ARCHITECT.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RESERVE CITY HALL FUND THROUGH FEDERAL

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville having established a Reserve City Hall Fund through Federal Revenue Sharing money, and

WHEREAS, some 1.9 acres has been acquired through donation of a City Hall site with one acre additional property being made available for purchase, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has deemed it necessary to proceed with planning architectural drawings and engineering proceedings to promote and construct a City Hall and in pursuance thereof did appoint a committee to act on the selection of an architect, and

WHEREAS, said committee after visitation to architects' offices, and much study and consideration did report to the Council and recommend four firms or architects for final selection, and

WHEREAS, the City Council on September 25, 1979, interviewed representatives of the four firms of architects, and

WHEREAS, the City Council found all four architects to be very well qualified and excellent architects, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after long and careful consideration, selects ___BALSIGER. SHEWBRIDGE_AND ASSOC. PC. for the purposes herein on the basis of the following findings:

- 1. He has dedicated time and means over a long period of time towards the welfare of the City and continues to do so.
- 2. He has maintained a long relationship with the City as an advisor on numerous committees and in the process has become intimately familiar with its administration and its practical needs in a City Hall facility.
- 3. He has substantial experience in the area of institutional and governmental buildings.

- 4. The Council found his recommendations for the formation of a committee to work with the architect in an advisory capacity for the best workable design for the site and his presentation of ways the City could expand an original building as space is needed to be sound and innovative advice.
- 5. Each of the four firms interviewed demonstrated outstanding qualifications and a sincere interest in Wilson-ville's needs, but in the Council's opinion the firm selected has a more intimate knowledge of the City's operational needs and problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council hereby resolves to hire

BALSIGER, SHEWBRIDGE AND ASSOC PC. as the architect to

design the Wilsonville City Hall. Adopted October 1, 1979.
