

RESOLUTION NO. CXL (140)

A RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING NEW WATER RATES AND CONNECTION CHARGES;
ESTABLISHING BULK WATER RATES AND HYDRANT CONNECTION FEES AND CHARGES;
ESTABLISHING RECONNECTION CHARGES WHEN SERVICE IS DISCONTINUED AND ESTABLISHING
EQUIPMENT USE DEPOSITS.

Section 1:

A. Costs of water service connections include, though not exclusively the following: Cost of meter, meter box, vault where appropriate, pipe for extending service line to the meter box at the property line if necessary, pipe fittings and labor necessary for making such installations, including the labor of any ditch digging and backfilling done or hired by the City, and any incidental administrative cost involved during installation. All meters two (2) inches and above will be compound meters.

B. After the effective date of this resolution, and except as provided in the following subsection (C), all approved applicants for City water service shall be charged the following connection charges which shall apply to each separate meter or new line regardless of line extension by City or applicant.

C. After the effective date of this resolution all approved applicants for City water service who require only a meter and its connection to a previously installed water mainline or service to property line of applicant shall be charged the following connection charge which shall apply to each separate meter:

D. Any applications for water service which have been disapproved shall be returned to applicant with the specific justifications for disapproval of said water service. All fees which have been collected pertaining to said water service shall be returned at this time.

Section 2:

The charges to be made as provided for in the foregoing section shall be paid in full to the City of Wilsonville Recorder or designated staff person at the time the application is filed for a water service connection. In computing charges for water service installations for water meters larger than one and one-half inches (1½"), the City's actual cost for the material

used, not diminished by any rebates from suppliers or payment of discounts, shall be the material cost billed to the water service applicant. An additional cost for installation and labor charges are indicated above in Tables I & II for all meter sizes.

Section 3:

A. All water, whether for industrial, commercial, or residential purposes, shall be sold in accordance with the following schedule of minimum monthly charge and rates: (see Table III)

MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGES FOR WATER FURNISHED OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS SHALL BE DOUBLE THE MONTHLY RATES.

B. "Excess Water" shall mean, metered water used each month which is in excess of 1000 cu.ft. for any meter size. After the effective date of this resolution, water users shall be charged \$0.50 per 100 cu.ft. after the first 1000 cu.ft.

C. All services 2 1/2" and larger shall be covered by specific written agreement with the City, but in no case shall the rates and charges be less than set forth above.

D. Standpipe services for fire protection shall be charged monthly at the rate of \$2.50 per inch of pipe in diameter, and all services for fire protection shall have a detection meter with valves and vault to comply with requirements of the City Water Superintendent or the District Fire Department.

E. All bills shall be due and payable on the 10th day of the month after billing; and if not paid within twenty (20) days thereafter, service will be turned off until payment is made of the amount due, together with the costs of disconnecting and reconnecting of service.

Section 4:

If water service hereafter furnished by the City of Wilsonville, pursuant to this resolution is disconnected by the City for failure of the customer to pay the prescribed charges for service or to abide by the established rules and regulations of the Water Department pertaining to such service, the following charges shall be made and collected by the City before reconnecting the service.

The full amount of the utility bill due at the time the service was disconnected plus the following additional service charges.

A. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) if reconnection of the service is requested to be made between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. or any day except Saturday, Sunday, or a designated City Holiday.

B. Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) if reconnection of service is requested to be made at any other time or on Saturday, Sunday, or a designated City Holiday.

Section 5: BULK WATER RATE

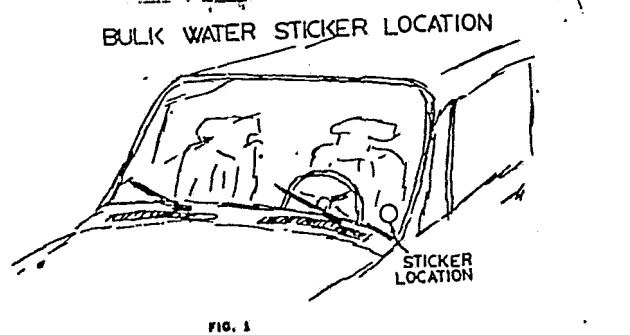
All bulk water sold after the effective date of this resolution shall be at the rate of .50¢ per 100 cu.ft. and full payment for all water purchased shall be made to the City of Wilsonville within 72 hours from date of purchase or when otherwise required.

Section 6: HYDRANT CONNECTION FEE

All applicants for purchase of bulk water shall pay a five dollar (\$5.00) connection fee, for each day fire hydrant is used. In addition, a fee shall be paid which includes a permit sticker which shall be located on the water hauling equipment on the lower left corner of the driver's front window. (See figure 1 below) The maximum days a permit will be issued is ninety (90) days and the permit must be renewed at the completion of the permit period, with inspection of all portable meter(s), fire hydrant valve(s), and hydrant wrench prior to approval of permit renewal. Also a new application will be filled out at this time. Permit fees are listed in Table IV.

Section 7: EQUIPMENT USE DEPOSIT


Table V identifies the deposits required for the use of portable water meters, fire hydrant wrenches and fire hydrant valves, by the applicant. The only item which is mandatory for completion of the application is the portable water meter.

If the above items mentioned are returned in good condition, a portion or all of the deposit shall be returned to the applicant. The Water Superintendent or designated staff person shall make the determination as to the amount of the deposit to be returned. If the applicant wishes to renew the deposit for another ninety (90) day period the applicant may do so with a portion or all of the previous deposit as designated by the Water Superintendent or designated staff person to be used as part of or all of the new deposit.


