

RESOLUTION CXLII (142)

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A TAX LEVY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, OREGON ON JUNE 24, 1980, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF LEVYING TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980 - 81.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville determined that a one year tax levy be established in order to permit the proper operation of the City affairs and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of levying taxes to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon

NOWHEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Wilsonville resolves as follows:

1. The levy set forth in Section 2 shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville at a tax levy election to be held on June 24, 1980.

If an established tax base of \$750,000 for the City of Wilsonville is approved by the legal voters of the City at the May 20, 1980 Primary Election, this Resolution shall become null and void.

2. At the City tax levy election, there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville for their approval or rejection, the following measure:

CAPTION: LEVYING TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980 - 81

(Submitted to the Voters by the Common Council)

QUESTION: Shall the City of Wilsonville be authorized to levy \$719,277 outside the constitutional limitation for financing City operations during 1980 - 81?

The voter shall put an (X) or a (✓) in the box between the number and answer voted for or punch the appropriate answer if a punch card ballot is used. Vote YES or NO.

PURPOSE: The City of Wilsonville presently does not have an established tax base, but is proposing a one year tax levy of \$719,227 to appear on an A and B ballot for 1980-81 fiscal tax year. The purpose of this tax levy is to provide revenue for the 1980-81 operation for the City of Wilsonville.

EXPLANATION: The proposed tax levy of \$719,227 will support the needs of the City for the 1980-81 fiscal year. The proposed services for 1980-81 are to be expanded to include a Municipal Court System, increased police protection (shall end on June 30 unless tax levy is approved), additional demands for maintenance and construction of City streets and capital outlay. The City's existing services include: water, sanitary sewer, storm drainage and street lighting; police protection; park facilities; street construction and maintenance; traffic control; and administration.

The tax levy will support the increased costs of the City's present services and the additional services that are being proposed for the fiscal year 1980-81.

If this measure is approved, \$20,087 of the taxes levied will be financed partially by the State of Oregon, which will result in an estimated rate of \$3.88 per \$1,000 true cash value exclusive of levies for bond principal and interest and serial levies for capital construction.

3. The above measure may be subject to change by the Wilsonville Common Council and filed immediately thereafter with the County Elections Office to appear before the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville for a tax levy election to be held June 24, 1980.

4. Notice of the City tax levy election shall be given by publication twice in the Tigard Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, not more than thirty (30) nor less than ten (10) days before the election. Notices of the tax levy election shall be posted not less than twenty (20) days before the election in three public places within the City. The notice in the newspaper and to be posted in public places shall be substantially the same as the ballot measure in Section 2 of this resolution.

5. The City Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notices required by Section 4 of this resolution. The notices.

of the City tax levy election required to be given by Section 4 shall constitute the only notice necessary. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Wilsonville or any official thereof to furnish the legal voters at the City tax levy election pamphlets containing either (a) the text of the proposition or (b) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.
