

RESOLUTION NO. CXLVII (147)

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH R. J. STRASSER CO. FOR A MUNICIPAL WATERWELL.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has heretofore advertised for and received bids which were opened at the City Hall on September 2, 1980, for construction of a new municipal waterwell near Tektronix; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications for said project were prepared by the City's engineers, Westech Engineering, Inc., of Salem, Oregon, and calls for bids were duly and regularly published in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened and read aloud at the Wilsonville City Hall on September 2, 1980, and the results of the bidding were reported to the Mayor and Wilsonville City Council by letter of C. H. Steketee, Project Manager, of the City's engineers dated September 2, 1980, and said letter report and bids were considered by the Wilsonville City Council at its regular meeting on Tuesday, September 2, 1980. There were a total of three (3) bids received as follows:

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council has considered the bids, the plans and specifications for said project, the contract documents generally, and the reports and recommendations of its engineers and City staff, and determined that the low bid is that of R. J. Strasser Drilling Co. for the bid amount of \$56,335 which includes an adjustment option by the City of developing either a 14" diameter well or a 12" diameter well and the right of the City to select the total depth of the well as discussed in the letter report to the Mayor and the Council by the Project Manager, C. H. Steketee, of the City's Engineers, dated September 2, 1980,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that:

1. The bid of R. J. Strasser Drilling Co. for construction of a municipal waterwell near Tektronix in the total amount of \$56,335.00, including an adjustment option by the City of developing either a 14" diameter well or a 12" diameter well and the right of the City to select the depth of the well after work has begun as set forth by the City's engineering firm in its letter to the Mayor and the City Council dated September 2, 1980, is hereby accepted for the amount of the contract for the construction of said project according to the plans and specifications as prepared by Westech Engineering, Inc.

2. The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville and on its behalf a contract with R. J. Strasser Drilling Co. for

construction of a municipal waterwell near Tektronix according to the plans and specifications therefor, and any changes or modifications of those plans and specifications as may be approved by the City Council and which said plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder.


3. Payment by the City of Wilsonville of the construction contract authorized by the foregoing Section 2 is to be made according to the schedule for payments as outlined in the contract documents.

4. In order to conserve financial resources, the Project Manager, together with those members of the Council as the Mayor shall appoint, shall determine the well diameter and the well depth without further Council action thereof.

5. In order that the construction work for the improvement project may be commenced as soon as possible an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution was adopted orally by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof on the 2nd day of September, 1980, and is hereby ratified by this written resolution thereof this 22nd day of September, 1980, by the City Council at a special meeting duly called.
