SUBJECT: Purchase of Engineers Level - Tripod - Rod

During the past seven months, the City of Wilsonville has rented a 1978 Dietz Engineers Level, Tripod, and 25 foot Telescopic Rod for \$180/month. Approved for the 1981/82 budget year on page 12, line 21 under Inspectors Equipment a sum of \$4420.00 was budgeted, however only \$3,000.00 was allocated for the Engineers Level, Tripod, and Rod.

The equipment that we rent from Precision Instruments from Portland is 1978 model and if purchased at new prices would cost a little less than \$3,000.00. It has always been a policy of Portland Precision Instrument that when you rent their equipment that \$450.00 of the rent paid applies toward the purchase price of the equipment. The City of Wilsonville has already paid rent for 7 months @ \$180.00/month = \$1,260.00.

In order for the City of Wilsonville to buy the equipment needed a total of \$1,550.00 would need to be paid to Precision Instruments.

Recommendation

The City of Wilsonville to purchase the Dietz Engineers Level, Level Tripod, and Elevation Rod from Precision Instruments for a total purchase price of \$1,550.00. The equipment is in excellent condition and would save the City an additional \$1,450.00 if the City were to buy a new Level, Tripod and Rod.
