III. Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Master Plan – Sherer

The Master Plan is viewed as a 10 year plan that will help to dictate the direction of the department including both programs and facilities. The plan will include: analysis of recreation trends, demographic information, a level of service standard, natural resource plan and an implementation plan for facilities. The plan will also develop department mission, vision and objectives.

IV. Recreation Aquatic Center Update – Sherer

City will issue an RFP for management of the Recreation Aquatic Center. The Parks and Recreation Department will be a respondent to the RFP. City needs to be able to compare their cost to run the facility to that of the private sector. Outside management companies are becoming more common in the Parks and Recreation industry. Recreation Aquatic Center will be on November ballot.

V. "Yes On" Committee for Recreation Aquatic Center – Councilor Starr

Councilor Starr showed the board a preview of the presentation he will utilize when speaking to community groups. Presentation highlighted the amenities (6 lane lap pool, warm water pool, leisure pool, fitness center, multi-purpose rooms, gymnasium with walking track and a climbing wall.)

Currently working to create a taskforce to help with presentations at community forums.

VI. Grant Process Update – Stevenson

The Board will continue to review both the City's Tourism Grant and the County's Community Partnership Program Grant for 2016. It was previously thought that the City's Tourism Taskforce would be reviewing the grants.
