## PUBLIC HEARING

A. URA Resolution No. 264 A Resolution Authorizing A Supplemental Budget Adjustment For Fiscal Year 2015-16.

Ms. Jacobson read the title of URA Resolution No. 264 into the record.

Chair Knapp called the public hearing to order at 7:46 p.m.

Cathy Rodocker presented the staff report. Oregon's Local Budget Law allows the URA Board to amend the adopted budget for an occurrence or condition that was not known at the time the budget was adopted. The Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget was adopted by the Agency on June 1, 2015.

The Eastside Urban Renewal district will recognize additional funding required for the Murase Mound Re-grade project (\$30,000) and project management fees for the Canyon Creek Extension Project, (\$5,000). The Westside Urban Renewal district will recognize the remaining funds from Fiscal Year 2014-15 for the Barber Street to Kinsman project (\$770,000).

A public notice for the Urban Renewal meeting was published as required in the March 15, 2016 edition of the Spokesman. Oregon Budget Law requires all budget adjustments and transfers be approved prior to the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2016. A table showing the changes in detail is shown below.
