ISSUE BEFORE AGENCY:

A supplemental budget resolution for the FY2020-21 budget year.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Oregon's Local Budget Law allows the URA Board to amend the adopted budget for an occurrence or condition that was not known at the time the budget was adopted. The Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget was adopted by the Agency on June 1, 2020.

Budget Adjustment Resolution

This supplemental will provide the funding for the Restaurant Relief Program through the Program Income Funds of the Westside District, totaling \$40,000 and from the Year 2000 District totaling \$40,000. Each program income fund generates its revenues from either sale of property, rental leases on property owned by the district or interest income. Being as the funding is not related to property taxes, the URA Board has less restrictions on how the money can be spent than our URA Capital Project/Debt Service Funds.

The funds, \$80,000 in total are being transferred to the City's General Fund for disbursement out of the ADMIN department as a special projects expense to qualifying restaurants, as per Resolution 2868.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

The Urban Renewal Districts are required to amend their respective annual budget in accordance with Oregon local budget law. It is required to have the supplemental budget adjustment approved by the Board during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting.

TIMELINE:

A public notice for the Urban Renewal meeting was published as required. The notice was published in the Wilsonville Spokesman on January 13, 2021. Oregon Budget Law requires all budget adjustments and transfers be approved prior to the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2021.

The amended budget provides for the delivery of services and construction of capital projects throughout the community.

ALTERNATIVES:

Not approving the attached supplemental budget could result in overspending current budget appropriations. The City is required to disclose all excess of expenditures over appropriations in the Comprehensive Annual Financial report.

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THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE URA RESOLUTION NO. 312

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET ADJUSTMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21.

WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal Board adopted a budget and appropriated funds for fiscal year 2020-21 by URA Resolution No. 307; and,

WHEREAS, unanticipated revenues and expenditures are expected to exceed the original adopted budget in some of the Agency's funds and budgetary changes are necessary within these funds to provide increased appropriation levels to expend the unforeseen revenues; and,

WHEREAS, ORS 294.480 provides that a government may increase the current year adopted budget through supplemental appropriations provided publication notice is met and a public hearing is held; and,

WHEREAS, all transfers from contingencies within the fiscal year to date aggregate have exceeded fifteen percent (15%) of the fund's total appropriations; and,

WHEREAS, all expenditure transfers within the fiscal year to date aggregate to not more than ten percent (10%) of the fund's total expenditures; and,

WHEREAS, to facilitate clarification of the adjustments in this resolutions Attachment A to this resolution provides a summary by fund of the appropriation categories affected by the proposed adjustments of budget appropriation and the purpose of the expenditure.

WHEREAS, consistent with local budget law and based upon the foregoing, the staff report in this matter and public hearing input, the public interest is served in the proposed supplemental budget adjustment.

URA RESOLUTION NO. 312

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NOW, THEREFORE, THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Agency adopts the Supplemental Budget to the Fiscal Year 2020-21 adopted budget by amending the estimated revenues and appropriations within the funds and categories as delineated and explained in Attachment A, attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

This resolution becomes effective upon adoption.
